АННОТАЦИЯ:

Регулирование стоимости услуг мобильной связи в роуминге является частью политики Евросоюза по созданию единого рынка телекоммуникационных услуг на его территории.

С 2007 г. в ЕС развивается концепция единого роумингового пространства, в рамках которой введено прямое регулирование тарифов на розничном и оптовом уровне. Мотивами введения регулирования роуминга являются защита прав потребителей, повышение доступности коммуникационных услуг и уровня конкуренции между операторами связи, стимулирование развития информационного обмена, личной и бизнес-активности граждан, что в свою очередь благотворно влияет на рост экономики в целом.

Regulation of cost of services of mobile communication in roaming is part of the policy of the European Union to create a single market of telecommunications services in its territory.

Since 2007, the EU has been developing the concept of unified roaming space in which introduced direct regulation of tariffs for retail and wholesale level. Motives for the introduction of the roaming regulation are consumer protection, increase the availability of communication services and the level of competition between operators, promoting the development of information exchange, personal and business activity of citizens, which in turn has a beneficial effect on the growth of the economy as a whole.
